### OVERVIEW

The Rebuilding Together NYC Salvage Store is a nonprofit retailer that houses gently used building materials, furniture, and appliances. Items for sale are salvaged by Rebuilding Together NYC staff members on project sites or donated by members of the general public. Launched in 2015, the Salvage Store furthers Rebuilding Together NYC's mission to build strong, sustainable communities in which low-income New Yorkers can thrive. All items are stored in our warehouse in Red Hook, Brooklyn and interested buyers are welcome to visit and make purchases by appointment during regular business hours.

### IMPACT

In 2016, Rebuilding Together NYC diverted 4.4 tons of reusable building materials, furniture, and appliances from the waste stream through item donations and deconstruction projects. These items were salvaged and then reused on Rebuilding Together NYC project sites, recycled, or sold to the general public to support the greater work of the organization.
