

# FALL REBUILDING DAY 2016

## BUILD A NEIGHBORHOOD.

On **Saturday, October 29<sup>th</sup>** Rebuilding Together NYC will host Fall Rebuilding Day—the annual neighborhood rebuild event that occurs on the last Saturday of every October. This year, we are headed to the Hurricane Sandy-damaged neighborhood of Gerritsen Beach, Brooklyn, where many residents continue to rebuild four years after the storm. Together with the support of corporate sponsors and volunteers, Rebuilding Together NYC will rebuild five homes, two community gardens, and install 100 solar-powered exterior lights on the exterior of homes. Help us rebuild Gerritsen Beach.

**HOME #1:** Three generations of the W. family live in this Gerritsen Beach home, which took over 10 feet of water during Hurricane Sandy. Critical repairs remain outstanding and the family is eager to restore their home to a safe and healthy condition. On Fall Rebuilding Day, Rebuilding Together NYC will install flooring, replace a window, paint the interior, and repair exterior siding.



**HOME #2:** The R. family basement was the neighborhood hang-out; friends would stop by on their way back from Kiddie Beach, catch a Giants game, and spend time together. When Sandy hit, everything downstairs was lost and the family continues to rebuild. This October, Rebuilding Together NYC will hang drywall, tape, mud, and sand, paint, and stain the floor.

**HOME #3:** The G. family, which includes three humans and three canines, has lived in their Gerritsen Beach home for over a decade. The house sustained structural damage during Hurricane Sandy and critical repairs remain outstanding. On Fall Rebuilding Day, Rebuild Together NYC will lay flooring, repair the drop-ceiling, break up and pour concrete slab, and tile a bathroom.





**HOME #4:** This Gerritsen Beach home has been in the M. family for 30 years. The owner is an active member of the community and looks after his elderly mother, who lives around the corner. With the canal as his front lawn, the homeowner sustained significant property damage during the storm. This October, we will be sanding and painting doors, installing kitchen cabinets, replacing a roof, and repairing the exterior of the home.

**HOME #5:** Mrs. P. has lived in her Gerritsen Beach home for over a decade. Shortly after the storm, her husband passed away and significant work remains in the home. On Fall Rebuilding Day with the help of volunteers, Rebuilding Together NYC will install flooring, complete ceiling repairs, and install a sump pump.



**COMMUNITY GARDENS:** Two community gardens in Gerritsen Beach provide an oasis for local residents to enjoy. Much like the rest of the neighborhood, the gardens were damaged by the salt water that flooded during Hurricane Sandy and are in need of further repairs. On Fall Rebuilding Day, volunteers will work to bring these gardens back to life by weeding, landscaping, and building picnic tables and benches for public use.

**LIGHT IT UP:** As part of our Neighborhood Revitalization initiative, Rebuilding Together NYC installs motion sensor, solar powered lights on the exterior of homes in specific neighborhoods. This idea came about immediately after Hurricane Sandy, when many residents were without electricity and in need of light to start the rebuild. This October, we will install 100 lights throughout Gerritsen Beach.
